

PARADE RULES FOR 2018

PARADE STARTS PROMPTLY AT 9:00 A.M. SATURDAY APRIL 14

PARADE CLASSIFICATION must be entered on parade entry form. If you fail to do so, you will be classified as #22, Non-Competitive.

Non-refundable entry Fees: Checks should be made out to Oakdale Saddle Club, and mailed to 453 W. H. Street Oakdale CA 95361

Applications will not be processed prior to receipt of the fee.

ENTRY NUMBERS and instructions will be mailed one week prior to the parade. All identification numbers must be placed or worn on both sides of entry in plain view for the judging team.

If you are **ASSOCIATED WITH ANOTHER ENTRY** where you need adjacent entry numbers and we did not provide you with consecutive ENTRY NUMBERS, **YOU MUST NOTIFY** the Parade Committee Chairperson **IMMEDIATELY**. NO Entry Numbers will be Changed less than FIVE DAYS PRIOR to the Day of the Parade.

ALL HORSE entries is a judged category must be present and ready for judging at 8:30am at the parking lot next to the High School. This rule is made by the CSHA, not the Oakdale Saddle Club, and may affect awards given. Riding on the parade route before lineup, is not allowed.

NON-HORSE ENTRIES are judged by the Oakdale Saddle Club.

NO SMOKING WHILE ON ROUTE!

PARADE ASSEMBLY TIME: Your entry packet (mailed a week prior to the parade) will contain -entry time, line up location, and parking information.

ENTRY LINEUP Parade official will be present to assist you with lining up.

Parade starts promptly at **9:00 am**

Multiple horses, vehicles or persons with the same entry number must proceed as one group (no spacing).

Maintain your spacing between entries and, PLEASE, not more than 50 feet at any time.

Participants must **MAINTAIN CONTROL OF THEIR VEHICLES AND ANIMALS** at all times.

No one under the age of six (6) years may be in control of a horse or vehicle without an adult, 18 years or older supervising.

ENTRIES CAN BE DISQUALIFIED FOR:

- Failing to maintain a maximum of no more than 50 feet or a minimum of no less than 25 feet from the preceding entry.
- Not completing the entire parade route.
- Refusing to obey parade marshals or police.

Allowable time for performing before the ANNOUNCING STANDS:

A ROUTINE of NO MORE THAN 60 SECONDS by any Entrant.

Equestrian Unites are limited to ONE COMPLETE CIRCLE.

A PENALTY OF 5 POINTS WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH VIOLATION FOR EXCESSIVE TIME.

Decisions of the judges will be final.
