## "RAIN OR SHINE"

# PARADE STARTS PROMPTLY AT 9:00 A.M. SATURDAY APRIL 13

**PARADE CLASSIFICATION** <u>must be entered</u> on parade entry form. If you fail to do so, you will be classified as #22, Non-Competitive.

**Non-refundable \$25.00 entry Fees:** Checks should be made out to Oakdale Saddle Club, and mailed to: Oakdale Saddle Club, c/o Rodeo Parade Organizer, Sutton Castillo PO Box 275 Oakdale, CA 95361 Phone # (209)541-5411

Applications will not be processed prior to receipt of the fee.

**ENTRY NUMBERS** and instructions will be mailed one week prior to the parade. All identification numbers must be placed or worn on both sides of entry in plain view for the judging team.

**ALL ENTRIES** will be judged by the Oakdale Saddle Club, Kat Country & Local Businesses.

If you are **ASSOCIATED WITH ANOTHER ENTRY** where you need adjacent entry numbers and we did not provide you with consecutive ENTRY NUMBERS, **YOU MUST NOTIFY** the Parade Committee Chairperson **IMMEDIATELY.** NO Entry Numbers will be Changed less than FIVE DAYS PRIOR to the Day of the Parade.

### NO SMOKING WHILE ON ROUTE!

**PARADE ASSEMBLY TIME:** Your entry packet (mailed a week prior to the parade) will contain -entry time, line up location, and parking information.

**ENTRY LINEUP** Parade official will be present to assist you with lining up.

Show up by 7:00 am. Parade starts promptly at 9:00 am.

Multiple horses, vehicles or persons with the same entry number must proceed as one group (no spacing).

Maintain your spacing between entries and, PLEASE, not more than 50 feet at any time.

Participants must MAINTAIN CONTROL OF THEIR VEHICLES AND ANIMALS at all times.

No one under the age of six (6) years may be in control of a horse or vehicle without an adult, 18 years or older supervising.

#### **ENTRIES CAN BE DISQUALIFIED FOR:**

- Failing to maintain a maximum of no more than 50 feet or a minimum of no less than 25 feet from the preceding entry.
- Not completing the entire parade route.
- Refusing to obey parade marshals or police.

Decisions of the judges will be final.
