- We DO NOT allow our queen to carry multiple titles, should our queen decide to run for another title she will forfeit the Miss Rodeo Oakdale Queen title, and crown and it will be passed on to the Princess.
- Should our queen not be able to fulfill her queen duties she will forfeit her crown, title and prizes and it will go to the princess.
- Should any contestant or family members do anything to harm anybody or misrepresent The Miss Rodeo Oakdale Queen Contest and the Oakdale Saddle Club at any time she will be disqualified immediately!
