

## **PARADE RULES FOR 2025**

### **PARADE STARTS PROMPTLY AT 9:00 A.M. SATURDAY APRIL 12, 2025**

**PARADE CLASSIFICATION** must be entered on parade entry form. If you fail to do so your entry will be classified as #22, Non-Competitive.

**NON-REFUNDABLE ENTRY FEES:** Check should be made out to: Oakdale Saddle Club Parade  
P.O. Box 1436 Oakdale, CA 95361

Applications will not be processed prior to receipt of the fee

**ENTRY NUMBERS** All identification numbers must be placed or worn on the right side of entry in plain view for the judging team

**ALL ENTRIES** will be judged by the Oakdale Saddle Club and Kat Country

If you are **ASSOCIATED WITH ANOTHER ENTRY**, where you need adjacent entry numbers and we did not provide you with consecutive entry numbers, **YOU MUST NOTIFY** the parade committee chairperson **IMMEDIATELY**. No entry numbers will be changed less than five days prior to the date of the parade.

**NO SMOKING WHILE ON ROUTE!**

**PARADE ASSEMBLY TIME:**

Staging Begins at 7:00am. Parade starts promptly at 9:00 am

Staging Location: Intersection West F St., N Oak Ave. and S Oak Ave. Oakdale, CA 95361

Multiple horses, vehicles or persons with the same entry number must proceed as one group (no spacing).

Maintain your spacing between entries and, PLEASE, not more than 50 feet at any time.

**Participants must always MAINTAIN CONTROL OF THEIR VEHICLES AND ANIMALS AT ALL TIMES.**

No one under the age of six (6) years may be in control of a horse or vehicle without an adult, 18 years, or older supervising.

**ALLOWABLE TIME FOR PERFORMING BEFORE THE ANNOUNCING STAND: ROUTINE NO MORE THAN SIXTY (60) SECONDS BY ANY ENTRANT**

**ENTRIES CAN BE DISQUALIFIED FOR:**

- Failing to maintain a maximum of no more than 50 feet or a minimum of no less than 25 feet from the preceding entry.
- Not completing the entire parade route.
- Refusing to obey parade marshals or police.
